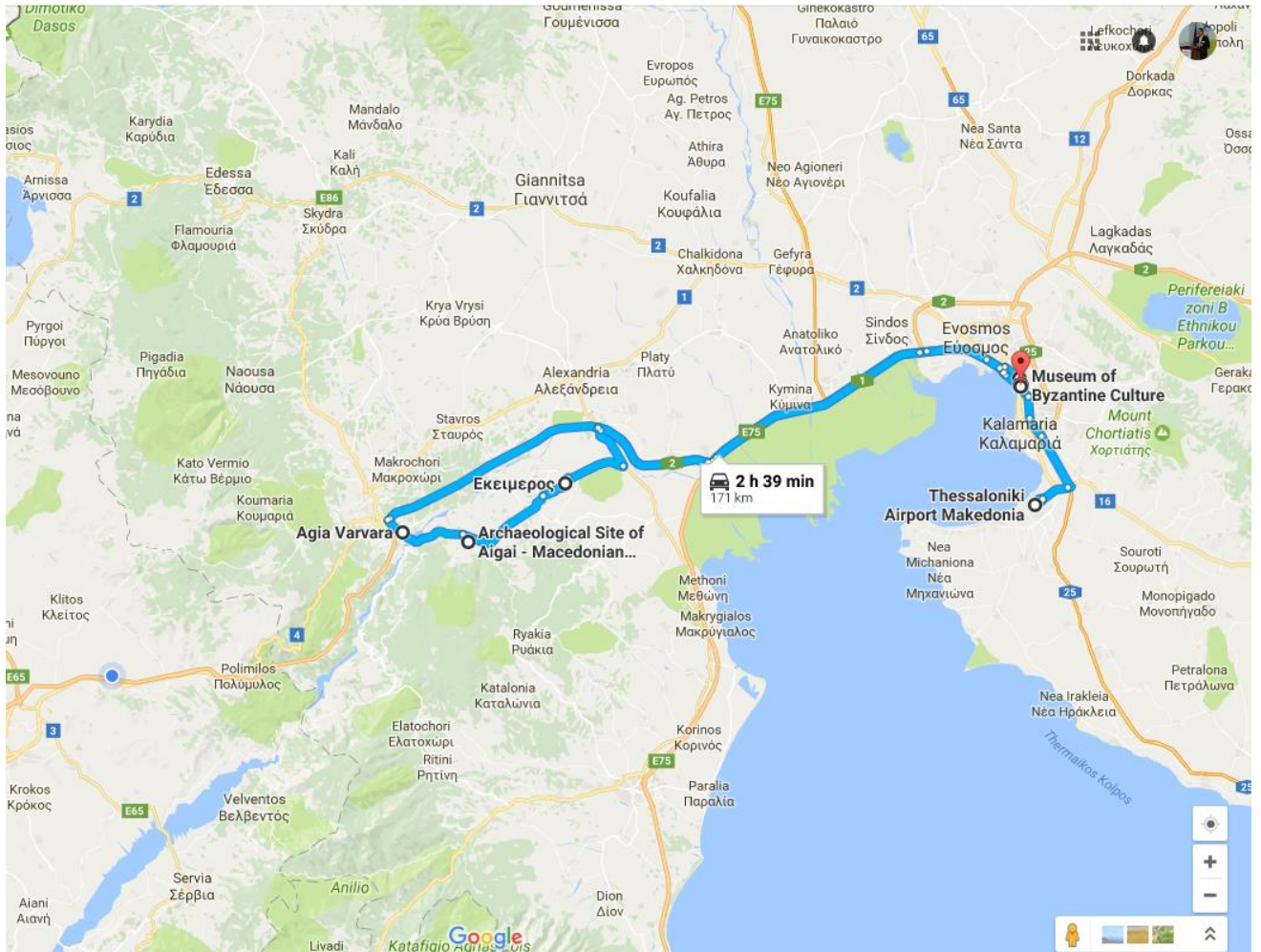
8:00	Departure from the City Hotel in Thessaloniki

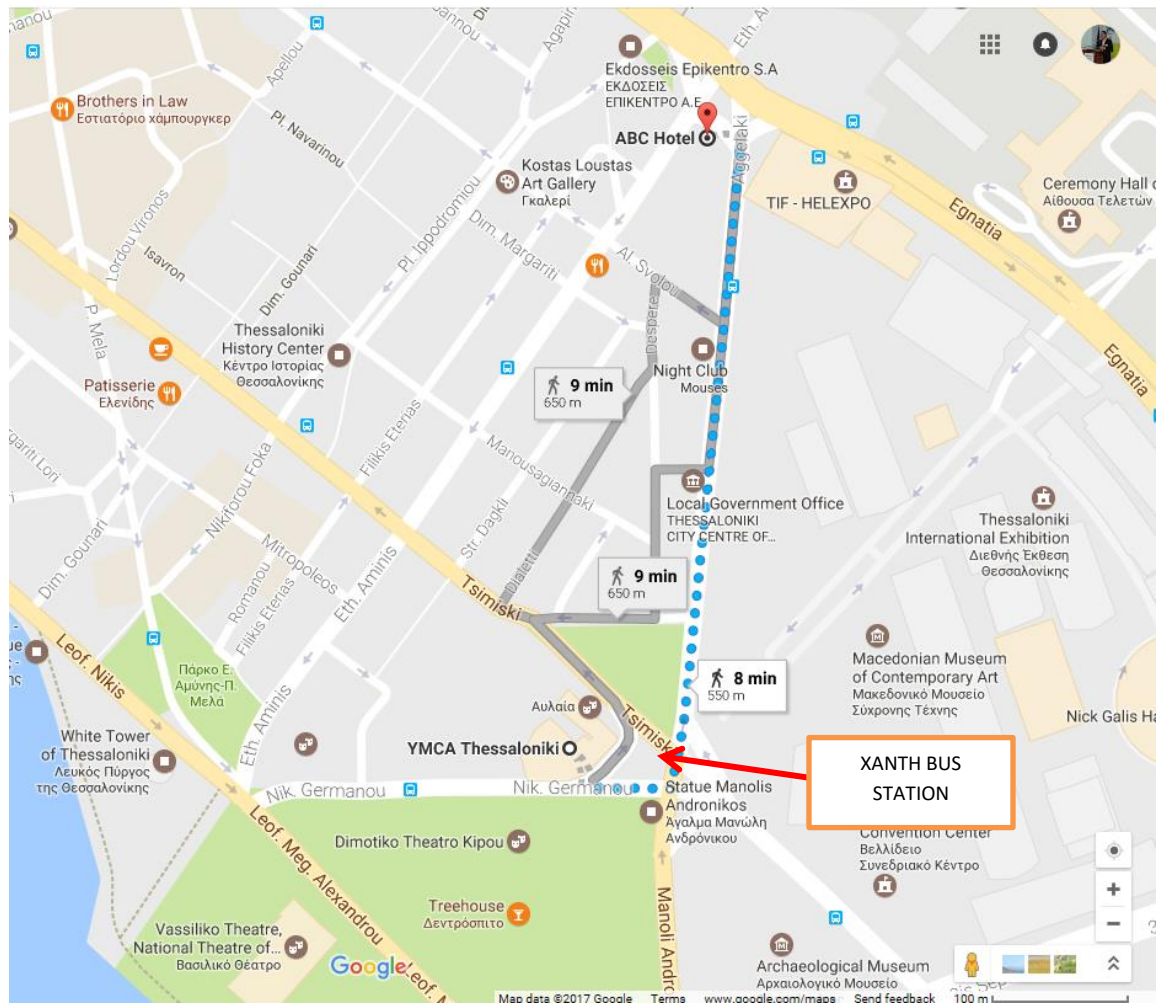

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

1. Ctrl + click on the map below to get the overall map of the 2 days events at your device or smartphone .



2. Transfer options from Thessaloniki airport to ABC hotel in the center of the city.
 - Taxi just outside the airport. The cost is about 12-15 euros depending of the arrival time.
 - Alternatively there is a bus itinerary from the airport every half an hour continuously. The bus no. is the 78 and the cost for a single trip is 1€. Please leave the bus at 'XANTH' (XANΘ bus station). It last about 45 minutes depending of the traffic. From that point you can walk for 500 m. in order to reach the hotel as it is illustrated at the map below.



3. Venue of event – Thessaloniki Town Hall
